Our vision and Mission is to educate and help our community prepare for, respond to and recover from emergencies, small or large, short or long-term.

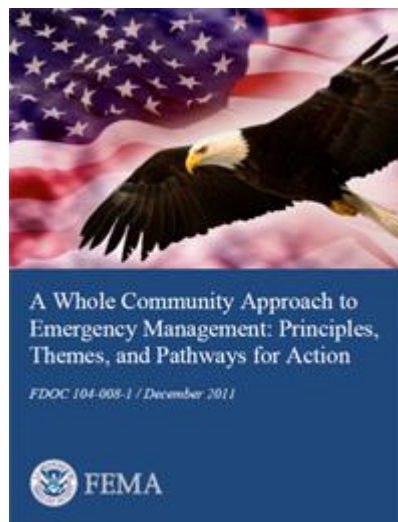
WHO WE ARE
